Médecins du Monde is organising the 10th edition of the Scientific Day of Humanitarian and Solidarity Health on Thursday, 10 April 2025. The event will take place at the Auditorium du Monde, 67-69 Avenue Pierre Mendès-France, 75013 Paris, and will also be accessible online.

This annual event is a valuable opportunity to discuss questions of health, vulnerability, and humanitarian action in France and abroad. It is an occasion to showcase the results of research and innovation in the medical-social field.

This year, we are looking at humanitarian action and knowledge in the face of populism.
